DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Add approximately 1/2 to 3/4 cup of Bull's Eye laundry detergent directly to wash wheel for each 100 lb of dry weight wash load. Run at usual temperature for regular wash cycle. For best results, use "hot" water cycle.
