DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use 2 to 12 ounces per gallon of 100-140°F water in CIP systems. Product use should be followed with a thorough potable water rinse. KC-416 may also be used for brightening and passivation of stainless steel and aluminum surfaces. This product should not come into direct contact with meat, shell eggs, or other food products.



In case of fire: Use CO2, dry chemical, or foam for extinction. Storage: Store locked up. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Disposal: Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant.
