

TRIPEX



Harmful if inhaled. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. May cause respiratory irritation. Prevention: Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Do not breathe dust/fume/gas/ mist/vapors/spray. Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves/

protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. **Response:** Immediately call a poison center or doctor. Specific treatment (see Section 4 on SDS). IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a poison center or doctor. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Immediately call a poison center or doctor. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting.

Storage: Store locked up. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed.

Disposal: Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant.
