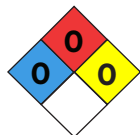

CC Natural Red is thick, rich hand soap intended for frequent application. It contains no harsh irritants, yet performs as a heavy duty hand cleaner. Rinses free of any slippery residue and is unscented. CC Natural Red can also be used as a light duty hard surface cleaner for washing lightly soiled equipment, utensils, containers, and other hard surfaces in food processing plants.

DIRECTIONS: Place approximately 5 mL of soap in the palm of hand, add sufficient amount of water to wet hands, and wash thoroughly in the normal manner. Rinse completely. For hard surface cleaning, mix 15-60 mL of CC Natural Red with 1 Litre of warm water and apply to surfaces by brush, mop, cloth, or soaking. Rinse thoroughly.
